Workshop on “International levers and local implementation of active ageing rights”, Pau (F), 5 September 2023

On the 5th of September 2023, a workshop was held in Pau, at the University of Pau and the Adour Region, within the project “International levers and local implementation of active ageing rights”. Funded by UniTo’s Grant for internationalization - GFI II CALL, under the scientific responsibility of Prof.ssa Lorenza Mola of the Law Department, the project addresses the question of whether and how the relevant international instruments, at both universal and European level, which are sources of obligations for States, provide local authorities with a substantial parameter in shaping public policies and realizing the rights relating to active ageing.
