

### UNITA at "Salone del Libro" international book fair in Turin

On 18th May professors Marcella Costa, Alessandra Fiorio Pla and Silvia De Marchis from the University of Turin presented UNITA at "Salone internazionale del Libro" book fair in Turin.

"Salone Internazionale del Libro" is Italy's largest trade fair for books, held annually in mid-May in Turin, Italy.

Prof. Costa, Fiorio Pla and De Marchis held a speech titled "International mobility without borders in the universities of the future: the challenge of the European Alliances".

#### **UNITA Rural Mobility call 2023**

**206 students** from 6 UNITA Universities applied to the UNITA Rural mobility call 2023.

Each Partner University selected students who applied to their own specific calls. The total number of **positions assigned is 113.** 

After accepting their position, students are currently filling in the forms required to register and are having the first online meeting and contacts with

the host organisations.

Rural Mobilities 2023 will start from June.

#### UNITA Green contest "ME&U TO CLEAN EU"

In May the green contest "Me&U to clean EU" involved students from the UNITA Alliance universities in a waste collection competition in the city parks.

Each UNITA partner University organised a competition involving local and Erasmus students. Participants joined the competition in teams: the first three teams collecting the biggest amount of litter and performing the best sorting were awarded with prizes and green gadgets.

In addition, some universities organised conferences on topics connected to green mobility, in order to promote respect for the environment and urban public spaces, and ensure that these good practices are widely accepted and shared.

### Matching event "Developing UNITA communities" - 26th and 27th June

On **26th and 27th June** the University of Turin will host the second matching event on research "**Developing UNITA communities**".

150 professors and researchers from Partner Universities and the Associated partners will join Torino and cooperate in 12 groups in order to create together a model for planning the future matching events and proceed with the creation of an international network of researchers working on new projects.

The programme will be available in the next few days.

#### **UNIGHT 2023 - UNITA Universities at work**

UNITA Universities are organising the activities to be presented on **29-30 September** during **UNIGHT 2023**.

UNIGHT is the "UNITA edition" of the European Researchers' Night: an immersive experience that involves researchers from five Countries with the aim of enhancing the dialogue between citizens and science, to actively participate in the most relevant social challenges of the present and the future.
