


UNITA at the European Student Assembly in Strasbourg

BIP UNITA BORDERS

The first edition of the UNITA Blended Intensive Program on the topic of borders involved 25 students from 9 universities and 16 European and non-European lecturers. The course explored - from an interdisciplinary perspective - the concept of borders from a cultural, social and political point of view in the context of the transformations taking place in different parts of the world: as areas of contact and exchange between nations and cultures, borders can also be the focus of discriminatory practices of exclusion, control and containment, for example by blocking or slowing down immigration or even causing conflicts between nations.
