GENERAL OBJECTIVES

To analyse, test and facilitate the use of a European Grouping of Economic Interest (EEIG) as an instrument of institutionalized cooperation, with the final goal of designing a new grouping, here named European Grouping of Academic Interest (EGAI).

The European Economic Interest Grouping (EEIG)

«Public education organised within the national educational system funded and supervised by the State may be considered as a noneconomic activity... but public institutions can also offer educational services which, due to their nature, financing structure and the existence of competing private organisations, are to be regarded as economic »

Communication from the Commission on the application of the European Union State aid rules to compensation granted for the provision of services of general economic interest (2012/C 8/02)

PROS

- EU legal framework, automatic recognition (genuine EU grouping)
- Flexible and unbureaucratic organization, mixed nature btw profit and not profit, full possibility of economic activities

....but it is not conceived for academic activities

(models of administrative decisions, contracts, regulation)
